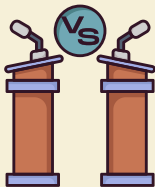

The chairman of Jeevan Vikas Shikshan Sanstha ,Shri Vagesh Kadam hoisted the flag and greeted the attendees.

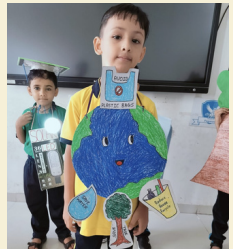

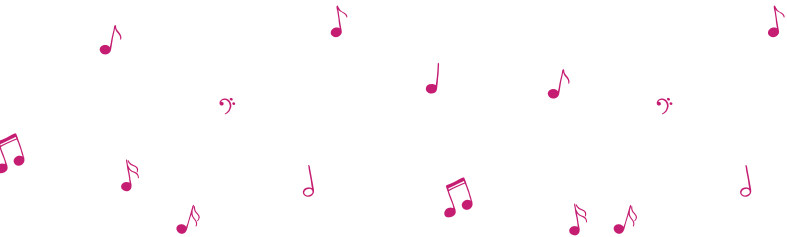
This competition promoted creativity, environmental consciousness, critical thinking, teamwork, and practical skills among our learners.

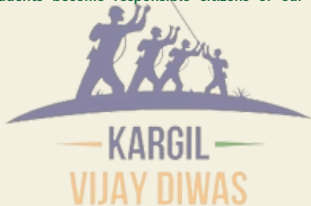

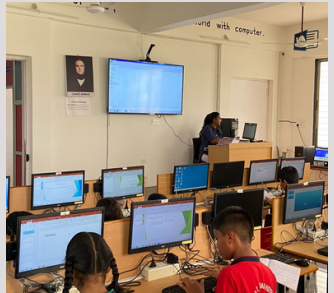

It was an Eco Club Activity.

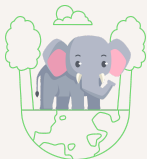

This was a beautiful beginning to many more experiences in life.





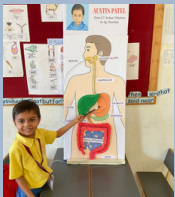
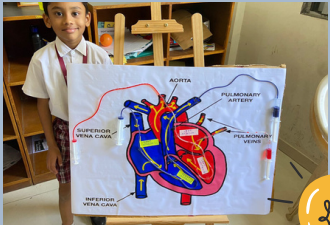
Vision 360 - Science Fest

We also learned about the different pollutants that can affect the quality of the water and how they can be harmful to the environment and to humans.

We visited a groundwater well & hand pump to understand how water is extracted from underground sources. We learned about the role of groundwater in providing water to communities and the importance of sustainable practices to ensure that the water source is not depleted.

Next, we saw a water treatment plant, the process of purifying and filtering water to make it safe for consumption. We learned about the importance of strict regulations to ensure that the water we drink is safe and clean.

Overall, the field trip was an eye-opening experience for all of us. It helped us appreciate the importance of preserving and protecting our water sources and the role that each of us can play in ensuring a sustainable water supply for future generations. We also gained a better understanding of the processes involved in providing clean and safe drinking water to our communities. It was a valuable learning experience, and we are grateful for the opportunity to gain firsthand knowledge about our local water sources.

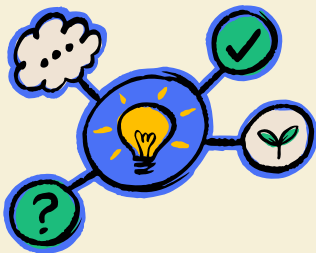

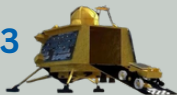
